

After Permanent Makeup Service

- Must keep the area dry for 10 days after service, this helps to ensure the pigment does not “wash out”
- **No** cleansers, makeup, or other products on the treated area- *except the ointment provided*, apply the ointment for 7-10 days after procedure.
- **No** extreme activity that generates excessive sweating- this can “wash out” the pigment- keep workout routines light and easy during the 10 days of healing.
- **No** touching the area with your fingers- use a Q-tip to apply ointment, and be careful not to pick or remove any scabs/dry skin- this will cause pigment to fall out or worse- scarring.
- **No** sleeping on your face during the healing period (10 days)- your skin may stick to the pillow case, and disrupt the healing process or worse- remove any pigments or scabs.
- **No** treatments on the face (facials, microdermabrasion, injections, chemical peels, etc.) for at least 4 weeks after permanent makeup service
- Pigment will be dark for the first week after procedure, and typically fades about 50% during the healing time.
